- 1. All lists are provisional. The school will communicate with candidates based on the list provided to the school timely E-counselling.
- 2. Please note that being shortlisted for the medical examination does not guarantee admission. Admission will be subject to:
 - 2.1 Successful clearance of the medical examination.
 - 2.2 Document Verification
 - 2.3 Timely payment of school fees (via Online Mode or Demand Draft in favour of "Sainik School Chandrapur", payable at SBI Ballarpur).
 - 2.4 No cash payments will be accepted.
- 3. Efforts will be made to complete the Medical Examination in one or two days. However, the admission process for each candidate may take **3–4 days** from the date of the medical examination. Therefore, candidates are advised to make necessary lodging and boarding arrangements on their own for a **minimum of four days** at Chandrapur/Ballarpur. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the Medical Examination. Please note that the Medical Examination may take even longer. Upon completion of the examination, candidates may leave the designated place only after obtaining permission from the school representative. Any additional expenditure incurred for medical tests/special investigations as part of the medical examination will be borne by the candidates/their parents.
- 4. If a candidate is found unfit during the initial medical examination, he/she may apply for a review medical examination. The candidate will need to stay nearby the school for 2–3 days for further communication and to receive the date for the review medical. The review medical examination will be conducted at a service hospital, and the details will be communicated separately.
- 5. If any candidate is absent for the medical examination, their candidature will be cancelled and the seat will be allotted to the next waitlisted candidate.

- 6. Candidates must bring the following documents for the medical examination:
 - 6.1 **Medical Form** (to be downloaded from the E-Counselling Portal or Annexure 'A' attached with the email. The candidate must fill out the first part of the form and bring it at the time of reporting.)
 - 6.2 **Birth Certificate** (issued by the Registrar of Births & Deaths as per the RBD Act, 1969, with a barcode affixed).
 - 6.3 **Aadhaar Card** (original and photocopy)
 - 6.4 Seat Allotment Letter
 - 6.5 AISSEE-2025 NTA Score Card
 - 6.6 Hall Ticket
 - 6.7 **Rs. 500/-** per candidate via online/UPI payment or Demand Draft drawn in favour of "*Principal, Sainik School Chandrapur*"
